Our older caterpillars are walking holding a teacher hand and we are so proud of them of how good is working.

They love spending time in the garden and at the playground, we tried some experiments using different materials and we can see how much they enjoy exploring with their senses. Celebrations

We started decorating our Lanterns for the party and singing the songs. We are ready to spend a lovely evening with all of you.

Arts and Crafts

- Crayons and leaves: our caterpillars showed a lot of interest in colors this month, they enjoyed sitting all together and making drawings with the crayons. We collected leaves from our garden days and we traced them on paper, it was a beautiful activity. They all felt so proud of the drawings and they wanted to take it home.
- Kites: autumn brings windy weather and it's the best time to fly kites. We used finger paint and brushes (mainly hands) to decorate the kites. They are now hanging form the sealing and every time the wind blows, we can see them move.
- Autumn leaves: this month was all about exploring with our senses. Using finger paint and hands we painted autumn leaves using the common colors and they are decorating the whole classroom. They are so beautiful.

Experiments

• Leave prints: we made a mix of flour, oil, warm water and salt to create a special dough. Once it was ready each got a bit of it and we had to use our

hands to make it flat. Using autumn material like, leaves, branches, and little pumpkins we did prints. It was very interesting to see the details on the dough. And of course, they enjoyed mixing all the ingredients together the most.

• Spider webs: a little had a bit of the Halloween spirit at the Caterpillars. Using paper plates, a wax crayon and water paint the Caterpillars made a perfect spider web. The very cool thing was that at first sight it was only a common paper plate, but once the caterpillars painted the surface with water color the pattern of the spider web appaired.

Nature and Environment

- Garden Time: we were out a lot this month we had all types of weather and we had a lot of fun. We like to collect the conkers and pine cones. They played in the sand and our current favorite activity is chasing the soap bubbles ③.
- Playground: we had a mazing time at the playground. They were all so happy to be there and we could see how much they enjoy the outdoors, sand and slides. The pictures talk for themselves.

Movement and Sport

• Turnzimmer time is already and we think it will be as well in the future one of the favorite times. They are always moving, climbing, crawling and even running around. In the Trunzimmer they feel comfortable with how much space they have. Using blocks, hula-hula's and the crawling tunnels they have the most wonderful time. We also danced and played music

Circle Time and Language

• Morning circle: we used visual support cards for the morning circle and we let them choose which song they will like to sing. They all get very excited to pick the song and place it in the middle of the circle. Sometimes it gets tricky to pick between, "Itsy Bitsy spider" and "Elephanten". We give the opportunity to all the caterpillars to pick the songs and this makes them feel part of the process, it works beautifully • Story time: we have our story time before lunch time and at this point, they majority are hungry and tired. Definitely not the best combination, but as soon as we start playing one of our audio books or showing them a book with animals, we get the attention back.

Julia's music class

- We had a lot of fun during music class. Julia always brings amazing material and instruments to play with the children. We played with the rainbow scarfs and explored with natural materials. Here is a list of the songs we've learned:
